

◆ Mac Attire Dress Code Checklist ◆

McLoughlin Middle School 2009-2010 Student Dress Standards



McLoughlin's "Mac Attire" standards reflect pride and dignity, and demonstrate that school is a place to study and to learn. Our "Mac Attire" supports student safety, establishes a focused and orderly school climate, and promotes equity among students of various economic levels. **ONLY THE CLOTHING ARTICLES LISTED BELOW ARE PERMITTED FOR THE MAC ATTIRE.** All staff members are responsible for monitoring dress code compliance.

Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, capris, jumpers:

- ◆ Style: plain (tan, navy, grey, or black)
- ◆ Pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, capris, and jumpers may be blue denim.
- ◆ **Blue JEANS are acceptable.**
- ◆ **NO LOGOS larger than a quarter are permitted.**
- ◆ Pants with anything other than stitching on pockets would be considered unacceptable.
- ◆ Hems are to be neatly and securely stitched.
- ◆ Holes in pants and frayed edges are not allowed.
- ◆ Shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers are to be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- ◆ Waistbands must fit and be worn at the waist, with waistband no more than 2 inches larger than the student's waist.

Shirts/Tops

- ◆ Only **solid** white, grey, black, or red and must **cover** the waistband of the pants or be tucked in.
- ◆ Shirts are to be no longer than mid thigh.
- ◆ **NO LOGOS larger than a quarter are permitted.**
- ◆ Undergarments must not be visible.

NOTE: Previous VSD and McLoughlin dress code guidelines will continue to be enforced. See Student Handbook.

Sweaters, sweatshirts, hoodies, pullovers, cardigans, fleece, and vests:

- ◆ **Solid** white, grey, black or red
- ◆ Shirts worn under the above must be solid red, white, grey, or black.
- ◆ **NO LOGOS larger than a quarter are permitted.**
- ◆ **MAC** sweatshirts and t-shirts **are** always acceptable.
- ◆ Sweatshirts are to be no longer than mid-thigh.
- ◆ **ONLY sweatshirts and hoodies of solid MAC Attire colors are permitted while on campus**

Shoes and laces:

- ◆ Shoes and laces are required at all times; No slippers. Flip Flops are ok. (not for PE)

Outerwear:

- ◆ Coats and other outerwear may not be worn in classroom.
- ◆ Coats must be placed on the back of the student's chair.
- ◆ Heavyweight; Quilted, hooded, zipped garments will be considered outerwear and **do not** have to match color code.

Jewelry:

- ◆ Jewelry is limited to small, appropriate for school items, such as watch, rings, necklace, and earrings.

****Religious Dress: No student shall be prohibited from wearing religious clothing and accessories as a result of Mac Attire.**
